



Brief information on your entry from a risk area

- You are entering Germany from a so-called risk area. According to the quarantine order
 of the state Baden-Württemberg, you must go straight home and self-isolate yourself (quarantine)
 immediately.
- 2. The self-isolation (quarantine) lasts 10 days.
- 3. You are **not allowed to leave your apartment within this period of time** and have visitors.
- 4. You have to register your entry at www.einreiseanmeldung.de.
- 5. You have to show a Corona-test result on request of the authorities. The test has to be made in Germany. The self-isolation (quarantine) can be shortened to five days in case of a negative test result which is made five days after entering Germany at the earliest.
- 6. If you continue your journey immediately and travel, for example, to Switzerland or Austria, these rules do not apply to you. Please follow the legal instructions on quarantine orders of the country you are entering into.
- 7. There are many **special regulations and exceptions**. Please keep yourself updated by looking directly at the website of the state of Baden-Württemberg, Sozialministerium.
